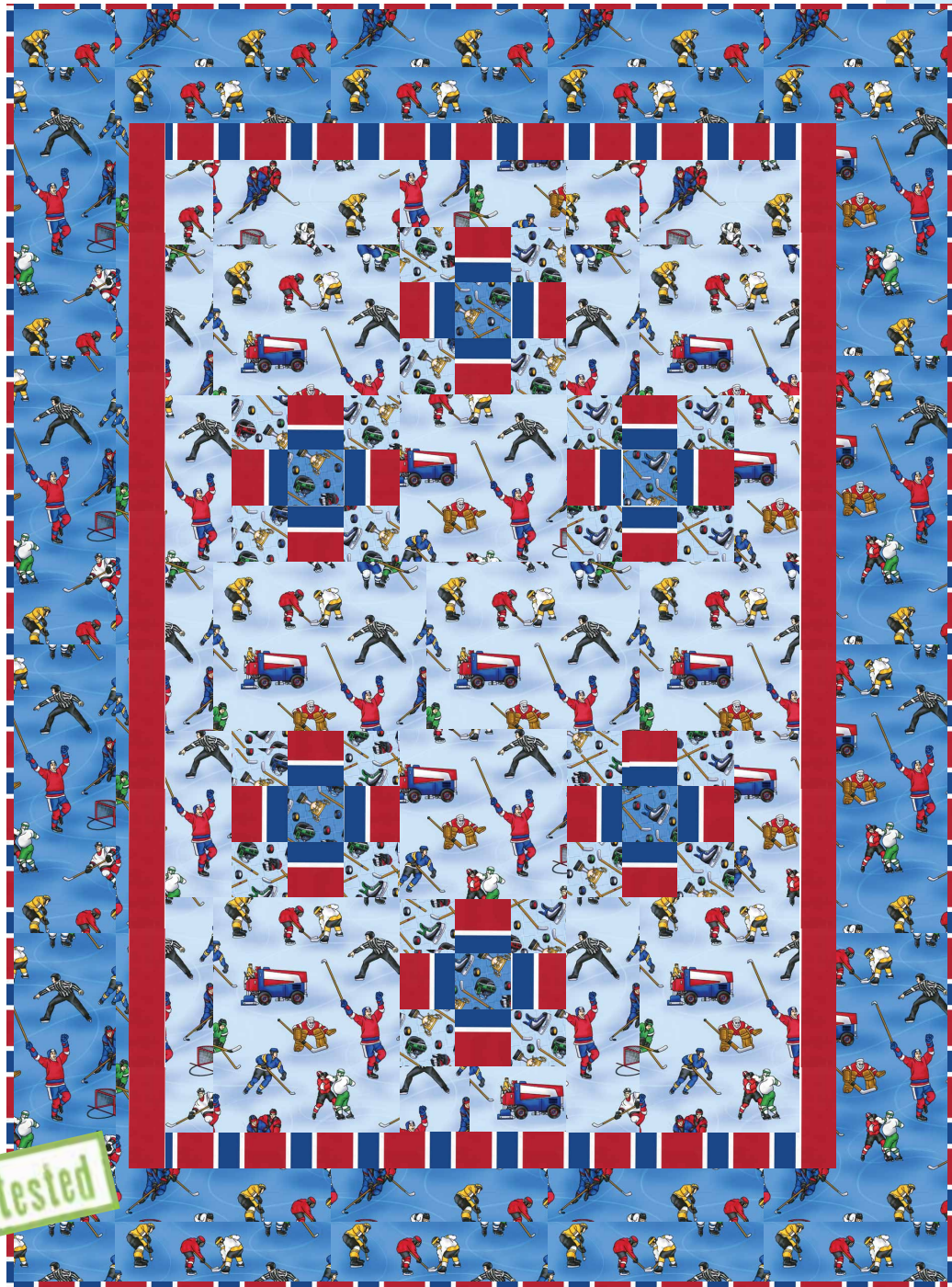


Face Off

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Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

1-3/8 yds	Lt Blue Main Print
1-1/8 yds	Dk Blue Main Print
1/4 yd	Lt Blue Equipment
1/8 yd	Dk Blue Equipment
1-3/8 yds	Red/Blue Stripe –includes binding
3-1/4 yds	Backing –fabric of choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

Cut pieces as listed from top to bottom:

From the Lt Blue Main Print cut:

- 1 – 9-1/2" x 34-1/2" WOF rectangle
- 4 – 13" squares
- 2 – 9-1/2" squares
- 4 – 9-1/2" x 4" **LOF** rectangles (see Figure 1)
- 2 – 4" x 9-1/2" WOF rectangles (see Figure 1)

From the Dk Blue Main Print cut:

- 2 – 6-1/2" x WOF strips (outer border)
- 6 – 6-1/2" x **LOF** strips (outer border)

From the Lt Blue Equipment cut:

- 24 – 3-1/2" squares

From the Dk Blue Equipment cut:

- 6 – 3-1/2" squares

From the Red/Blue Stripe cut:

- 2 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips (inner border)
- 6 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips (binding)
- 4 – 2-1/2" **LOF** strips – fussy cut, centering the red stripe down the strip (inner border)
- 4 – 3-1/2" **LOF** strips - fussy cut, cutting one edge a scant 1/4" outside of the blue stripe, then crosscut into: 24 – 3-1/2" squares (nine patches)

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. Clothworks is not responsible for printing errors.

Directions

Make the Nine Patch Blocks:

1. Layout four 3-1/2" Lt Blue Equipment squares, four 3-1/2" Red/blue Stripe squares and one 3-1/2" Dk blue Equipment square in the nine patch arrangement, using the image as a guide.
2. Sew three squares together in each row across, pressing seams toward the stripe blocks. Sew the three rows together to make a square which should measure 9-1/2".
3. Repeat to make six nine patch blocks.

Make the quilt center:

Note: Double check the direction of the skaters in the main print as you sew the blocks together and add the borders.

1. Layout the nine patch blocks with the 9-1/2" and 13" squares and assorted rectangles of the Lt Blue Main Print (Figure 1). Sew the 4" x 9-1/2" rectangles to the appropriate side edges of each nine patch block. Press toward the rectangles.
2. Sew the nine patch blocks, squares and rectangles into five horizontal rows. Press the seams away from the nine patch blocks.
3. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

Add the borders:

1. Measure the quilt across the center. Trim two Red/Blue WOF strips to this length, centering the stripe (or as desired).
2. Sew these strips to the top and bottom edges of the quilt.
3. Sew two 2-1/2" Red/Blue Stripe LOF strips together, end to end. Press. Repeat with the remaining two strips.
4. Measure the quilt from top to bottom. Trim the two strips to this length and sew to each side edge of the quilt.
5. Measure the quilt across the center. Trim two Dk Blue Main Print WOF strips to this measurement. Sew these borders to the top and bottom edges of the quilt.
6. Measure the quilt from top to bottom. Piece the Dk Blue Main Print LOF strips together end to end and trim two borders to this length. Sew these borders to each side edge to complete the quilt top.
7. Layer and quilt as desired. Bind and label to finish.

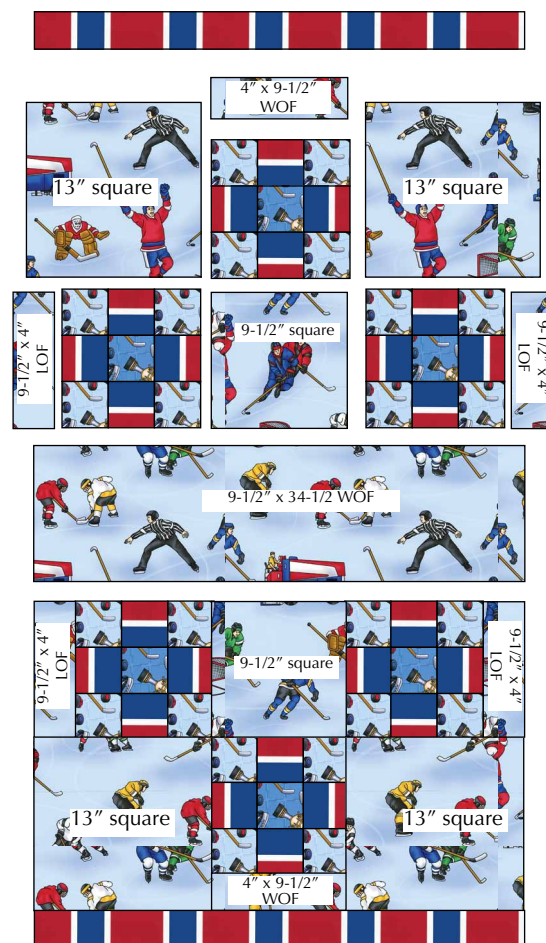
