## Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1 Yard - Purple Large Bunny (19060-2)
- 1/4 Yard - Purple Eggs (19061-2)
- 1/4 Yard - Yellow Eggs (19061-4)
- 1/4 Yard - Blue Baby Bunny (19062-1)
- 1/4 Yard - Pink Baby Bunny (19062-5)
- 1/8 Yard - Blue/Green Plaid (19063-1)
- 1/2 Yard - Pink/Purple Plaid (19063-2)
- 1/8 Yard - Yellow/Green Plaid (19063-3)
- 3/8 Yard - Green Splatter (19064-3)
- 1 1/4 Yard - Yellow Splatter (19064-4)
- 3/4 Yard - White Splatter (19064-6)
- 1/8 Yard - Purple Floral (19065-2)
- 1 Yard - Green Floral (19065-3)
- 1/8 Yard - Pink Floral (19065-5)
- 3 Yards - Backing of your choice
- Suggested: Green Large Bunny (19060-3)

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

### From the Purple Large Bunny cut:

- 5 - 6 1/2" x WOF strips pieced into
- 2 - 6 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips
- 2 - 6 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips

### From the Purple Eggs and Yellow Eggs cut from each:

- 2 - 2 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles
- 1 - 1 1/2" x WOF

### From the Blue Baby Bunny and Pink Baby Bunny cut from each:

- 2 - 2 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles
- 1 - 1 1/2" x WOF

### From the Blue/Green Plaid and Yellow/Green Plaid cut from each:

- 1 - 1 1/2" x WOF

### From the Pink/Purple Plaid cut:

- 76 - 2 1/2" squares
- 2 - 1 1/2" x WOF

### From the Green Splatter cut:

- 56 - 2 1/4" squares

### From the Yellow Splatter cut:

- 14 - 4" squares
- 8 - 3 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles
- 2 - 3" x 24 1/2" strips
- 2 - 2" x 35 1/2" strips
- 56 - 2 1/4" squares
- 16 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 32 - 1 1/2" squares

### From the White Splatter cut:

- 76 - 2 1/2" squares
- 2 - 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips
- 2 - 1 1/2" x 28 1/2" strips

### From the Purple Floral and Pink Floral cut from each:

- 2 - 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
- 4 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

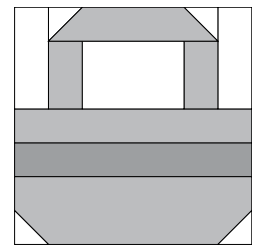
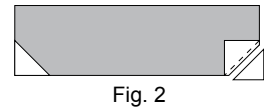
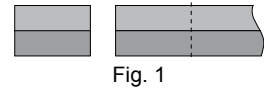
### From the Green Floral cut:

- 6 - 2 1/2" x WOF binding strips
- 2 - 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips
- 2 - 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" strips
- 4 - 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
- 8 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

## Directions

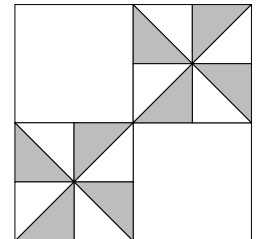
### Basket Blocks

1. Create a strip set by sewing together a 1 1/2" x WOF Pink Baby Bunny strip and a 1 1/2" x WOF Pink/Purple Plaid strip and press. Cut the strip set into two 7 1/2" sections (Fig. 1).
2. Place a 1 1/2" Yellow Splatter square on the corner of a 2 1/2" x 7 1/2" Pink Baby Bunny rectangle. Sew across the square diagonally as shown and trim within 1/4" of the seam (Fig 2). Repeat for the other corner. Make a total of two units.
3. Sew the units from step 1 to the top of the units from step 2. Repeat for a total of two units.
4. To create the handle, sew a 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Pink Floral rectangle to each end of a 3 1/2" x 2 1/2" Yellow Splatter Rectangle and press.
5. Using the same technique as used in step 2, place a 1 1/2" Yellow Splatter square on the end of a 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" Pink Floral rectangle and sew across diagonally. Trim within 1/4" of the seam and press. Repeat for the other side. Sew this unit to the unit from step 4. Repeat to make a total of two units.
6. Sew a 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Yellow Splatter rectangle to the ends of the units from step 5 and press. Sew the completed handle unit to the top of the basket completed in step 3 (Fig 3).
7. Referring to the diagram for color, repeat these steps to make the remaining baskets. Make two of each color for a total of eight baskets. The finished block should measure 7 1/2" squares, including seam allowances.



### Pinwheel Blocks

1. Place a 2 1/4" Yellow Splatter square on top of a 2 1/4" Green Splatter square. Sew across it diagonally. Trim to within 1/4" of the seam and press open. Repeat for a total of fifty-six triangle squares.
2. Sew four of the units from step 1 together to create a pinwheel.
3. Complete seven pinwheel blocks by sewing together the units from step 2 and the 4" Yellow Splatter squares (Fig. 4). The finished block should measure 7 1/2" square, including seam allowances.



### Putting It Together and Borders

1. Referring to the diagram for placement, sew the completed blocks together into rows and then sew rows together.
2. Sew the 2" x 35 1/2" Yellow Splatter strips to the sides of the quilt top and press. Sew the 3" x 24 1/2" strips to the top and bottom and press.
3. Sew the longer Green Floral strips to the sides of the quilt top and press. Sew the shorter Green Floral strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top and press.
4. Repeat step 3 using the White Splatter strips.
5. Place a 2 1/2" White Splatter square on top of a 2 1/2" Pink/Purple Plaid square and sew across it diagonally. Trim to within 1/4" of the seam and press. Repeat for a total of seventy-six triangle squares.
6. Sew twenty-two of the triangle squares together as shown (Fig. 5) and sew this border to the side of the quilt top. Repeat for the other side. Sew sixteen of the triangle squares together and sew this border to the top of the quilt. Repeat for the bottom.
7. Sew the 6 1/2" x 48 1/2" Large Purple Bunny strips to the sides of the quilt top and press. Sew the remaining two Large Purple Bunny strips to the top and bottom and press.
8. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.
