“Jenean Morrison Collection” Quilt
50” x 50”
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<u>Materials</u>	<u>Yardage</u>	<u>Cutting</u>
JM10-yellow	fat ¼	cut (12) 4 ½” squares
JM10-pink	fat ¼	cut (12) 4 ½” squares
JM11-brown	fat ¼	cut (12) 4 ½” squares
JM05-pink	fat ¼	cut (12) 4 ½” squares
JM08-white	½yd	cut (28) 2 ½” squares
		cut (38) 3” squares
JM01-pink	½yd	cut (24) 2 ½” squares
		cut (30) 3 squares
JM09-tan	3/8yd	cut (21) 3”squares
		cut (7) 5” squares
JM07-brown	3/8yd	cut (18) 3”squares
		cut (6) 5”squares
JM06-brown	¼yd	cut (2) 1½” x 40½”
		cut (2) 1½” x 42½”
JM03-brown	1yd	cut (2) 4½” x 42½”
		*cut (2) 4½” x 50½”
		*cut (5) 2¼” x W.O.F.

*Piece as needed to get length.

Also needed:

55” x 55” batting
55” x 55” backing
thread to match
scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler, mat

Directions:

1. For 4 patch block sew one each 4½” square JM10-yellow, JM10-pink, JM11-brown and JM05-pink together to make 8½” square block. Make (12) total. Set aside.
2. For Old Maid’s Puzzle block make (7) of combination “A” – JM08-white and JM09-tan and make (6) of combination “B” - JM01-pink and JM07-brown. To make one block, place right sides together one light and one dark 3” square. Draw a line diagonally from one corner to the opposite corner. Stitch ¼” on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart. Trim each right triangle square to an accurate 2½” square. Make two more sets. Sew four triangle blocks to light 2½” squares. Sew together in pairs to make two 4-path 4½” square units. Cut two 3” light squares in half diagonally. Sew one light triangle to each side of remaining right triangle blocks to make a larger triangle. Trim to an accurate 4½” on each side of triangle. Trim excess from diagonal side. Cut 5” dark square in half diagonally. Sew to pieced triangle along diagonal side. Trim finished unit to an accurate 4½” square. Sew one 4-patch unit to one triangle unit. Make 2. Sew pairs together into one 8½” 4-patch.
3. Row 1, 3 and 5 – begin and end with Old Maid’s Puzzle and alternate with 4-patch block. Row 2 and 4 – begin and end with a 4-patch block. Row 2 and 4 – begin and end with a 4-patch block and alternate with Old Maid’s Puzzle. Join rows together in sequence matching seams.
4. Sew one JM06-brown 1½” x 40½” strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one 1½” x 40½” strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one 1½” x 42½” strip to each side of quilt.
5. Sew one JM03-brown 4½”x 42½” strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one 4½” x 50½” strip to each side of quilt.
- 6.Layer, backing, batting and quilt top. Baste.
- 7.Quilt as desired.
- 8.Bind with JM03-brown to finish.
