TINY TAILORS QUILT

Designed by Janet Wecker Frisch

Size: 56" x 76"

Skill level – Intermediate

Cutting:

20986 G – Cut panel to get a 24½" x 44½" rectangle.

20990 A – Cut three strips 4¼" by width of fabric and four strips 2½" by width of fabric.

20989 G – Cut three strips 4¼" by width of fabric.

20987 B – Fussy cut two strips 11¼" x 28½". Fussy cut two strips 11¼" x 48½".

20991 A – Cut seven strips 2" by width of fabric.

20992 G – Cut 72 squares 5" x 5" for prairie points.

20988 E – Cut and piece yardage to form quilt back.

Construction:

Sew with ¼" seam allowance and all fabrics right sides together. Press each seam toward the darker fabric as you sew.

Center of Quilt

1. Sew ends of 20990 A 2½" strips together. Cut strip into two 44½" lengths and two 26½" lengths. Sew the two 44½" strips to the sides of the 20986 G panel and the two 26½" strips to the top and bottom of the 20986 G panel.

2. Sew 20990 A and 20989 G 4¼" by width of fabric strips together to form Strip Set 1 and Strip Set 2 as shown. Cut Strip Set 1 crosswise into eight 4¼" x 11¼" rectangles and Strip Set 2 crosswise into four 4¼" x 11¼" rectangles.

3. Join rectangles to form four 9-patch blocks as shown

4. Referring to the quilt diagram for placement, sew 20987 B 11¼" x 48½" fussy cut strips to sides of quilt. Sew 9-patch blocks to each end of 20987 B 11¼" x 28½" fussy cut strips and join to quilt center.

5. Sew ends of 20991 A strips together with diagonal seams. Cut strip into two 71" lengths and two 54" lengths. Join the 71" lengths to the sides of the quilt and the 54" lengths to the top and bottom of the quilt

Layer and quilt as desired.

IMPORTANT: Do not quilt in the 20991 A outer border.

Prairie Point Binding:

1. After quilting is complete cut outer border through all layers to a width of 1". If desired, trim ¼" from free edge of batting. Turn backing and batting to back of quilt, pinning in place and leaving 20991 A border free.

2. Make Prairie Points by folding each 20992 G 5" square diagonally, then folding diagonally again to form a folded quarter square triangle.

3. With right side of quilt facing up, arrange 15 folded triangles along top edge of quilt, 15 folded triangles along bottom edge of quilt and 21 folded triangles along each side of quilt, overlapping triangles slightly and placing folded edge of triangle within the "tails" of the previous triangle in the row. Raw edges of triangles should be placed along the raw edge of the 20991 A border. Do not overlap triangles at corners. Carefully pin in place.

4. Sew triangles to border with a ¼" seam. Press seam toward border. Points of triangles should face out after pressing.

5. Fold edge of backing ¼" to wrong side and hand stitch backing to triangles, covering seam.
