Speaking of *Creative Expressions*, Issue 17 (30566) featured some designs from OESD. **Flowers...Plus** is a wonderful look, with printable backgrounds and a sample sheet of

photo transfer paper included. 20262 (\$119.00) It offers really unique projects, and uses Fusible Poly Mesh Stabilizer (76159, 76162) and OESD Iron-On Transfer Paper (31969, 31970).

Another rising star in our machine embroidery popularity is **Anita Goodesigns**. This series has great value in its designs and projects, and a wide variety. Each



multi-format CD has great tutorials to help you with the projects, and a sizing program. We get new collections every month, so you'll be seeing even more from this talented company. They're all doing well, but the **Designer Rose** series has been a stand-out. For instance, the first one has 60 gorgeous designs with instructions so that the garment doesn't feel bulletproof when you're were finished. Tutorials tell you what top industry designers use on their garments to create stunning results that look like you paid a fortune: pocket embroidery, distressing, attaching embroidery to denim without hooping and much more. This collection includes floral motifs, running stitch designs, and scroll designs for borders. You can probably learn something new with Designer Roses, 32310 and Designer Roses 2, 32311 (\$59.95 each)

Lace Bookmarks is a collection of 20 Designs, with one for every occasion. Whether it is Mother's Day, a birthday or even a holiday you can find the right one. Some of the designs have an opening at one end so you can dress them up by adding a ribbon, beads or even a tassel. 32340 \$29.95 Be sure to check them all out.



Cindy Losekamp's popular **Crocheted Laces and Edgings** is now available in the Husqvarna Viking Designer SE version! Cindy has been doing this technique for a long time,

and now covers most top-of-the line machines! We love what she does with this, both by using the decorative stitches and in the embroidery designs that are included. I'm so glad she added the Designer SE! 32432 (\$39.95)

We have a few new fun collections from Michelle. Her **A Very Sweet Tea Party** Collection has four projects, a tea cozy, placemat, a set of pot holders and a sweet matching apron for adult and child!



There are 9 designs (for 5" x 7" hoops) to coordinate with the projects and templates to make beautiful scallops. 33149 (\$34.99)

Her other collection, **Floral Delight**, is something really different! There are 8 designs for needle felting (or painting!) and eight more delightful embroidery designs (also for 5" x 7" hoops)

with an open and airy look. There are also instructions and techniques for a simple and elegant pillow collection. 33486 (\$49.95)

The **Field of Flowers** collection offers three ways of stitching, depending on your time and inclination. There's traditional embroidery with 4 different lace fills



for the flower, all appliqué, where flowers and leaves are appliquéd, or a combination, where the flowers are appliquéd with lace fills for the leaf and petal. The quilt shown is 53" x 68". 33227 (\$30.00)

Bright Hope has a cute spring bouquet of 5 easy flower applique designs for your 4" x 4" embroidery hoop, with 3 easy projects to make: Baby Quilt, 4 Placemats and a Table runner. 33221 \$12.00



Laurel Burch has a new collection of cats. This one is **Feline Fairies**. A lot of cat lovers like the angelic version (at least in fantasy) and if you're also among

the many Laurel Burch fans, this multi-format CD is purr-fect for you! There are 24 feline fairies, and the selection is rounded out with lots of flowers and stars. 33275 (\$119.00)

The **Classic Monograms** with scrolls and leaves is perfect for linens, heirloom garments, wedding items. There's a complete alphabet, several words, and frames and smaller adornments. Beautiful! 33274 (\$119.00)
