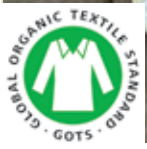

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Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide *unwashed* fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

1/4 yd Green Stripe (Y0774-19)
 1/2 yd Purple Stripe (Y0774-27)
 1/4 yd Orange Stripe (Y0774-36)
 1/4 yd Green Med Animals (Y0775-19)
 1/4 yd Purple Med Animals (Y0775-27)
 1/4 yd Orange Med Animals (Y0775-36)
 3/4 yd Lt Green Bushes (Y0777-18) (inc binding)
 1/2 yd Lt Purple Bushes (Y0777-26)
 1/4 yd Lt Orange Bushes (Y0777-35)
 3/8 yd Lt Green Sm Animals (Y0779-18)
 1/2 yd Lt Purple Sm Animals (Y0779-26)
 3/4 yd Lt Orange Sm Animals (Y0779-35)
 1/8 yd Black Everyday Organic Y0890-3)
 1/8 yd Orange Everyday Organic (Y0890-37)
 3 yds Backing of choice
 Fusible web: 1/8 yard

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

Cut from Green Stripe:

5 – 6 1/2" squares

Cut from Purple Stripe:

1 – 7 1/4" square (cut twice on diagonal to make 4 triangles)

1 – 6 7/8" square (cut once on diagonal to make 2 triangles)

5 – 6 1/2" squares

Cut from Orange Stripe:

1 – 6 7/8" square (cut once on diagonal)

5 – 6 1/2" squares

Cut from Green Med Animals:

4 – 6 1/2" squares

1 – 3 1/2" square

Cut from Purple Med Animals:

6 – 6 1/2" squares

Cut from Orange Med Animals:

6 – 6 1/2" squares

Cut from Lt Green Bushes:

6 – 6 1/2" squares

6 – 2 1/2" wide x WOF strips (binding)

Cut from Lt Purple Bushes:

5 – 6 1/2" squares

1 – 3 7/8" square (cut once on diagonal)

1 – 3 1/2" square

Cut from Lt Orange Bushes:

6 – 6 1/2" squares

Cut from Lt Green Sm Animals:

2 – 3 1/2" x 20" rectangles (top border section)

2 – 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles (side border sections)

Cut from Lt Purple Sm Animals:

2 – 3 1/2" x 20" rectangles (border)

4 – 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles (border)

2 – 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle (border)

Cut from Lt Orange Sm Animals:

1 – 7 1/4" square (cut twice on diagonal)

1 – 6 7/8" square (cut once on diagonal)

2 – 6 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles

5 – 6 1/2" squares

1 – 3 7/8" square (cut once on diagonal)

2 – 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

2 – 3 1/2" squares

Cut from Black Everyday Organic:

2 – prepared fusible circles (eyes)

Cut from Orange Everyday Organic:

1 – 3 1/2" square – cut first

14 – 1" x 5" strips (can be torn and frayed)

Making the Giraffe Pieced Blocks

1. On the back of the 3 1/2" Green Med Animals square, pencil a diagonal line from corner to corner (figure 1). Place right sides together the square on a 6 1/2" Lt Orange Sm Animals corner (figure 2). Sew on the penciled line, trim away corner triangles leaving 1/4" seam allowance and press open the corner. Repeat, marking a 3 1/2" square of Lt Purple Bushes and sewing to a second 6 1/2" Lt Orange Sm Animals square, as shown in the quilt picture. Repeat once more, sewing a 3 1/2" square of Orange Solid to a third 6 1/2" Lt Orange Sm Animals square.
2. Sew a 3 7/8" Lt Purple Bushes triangle right sides together to a 3 7/8" Lt Orange Sm Animals triangle (figure 3). Repeat to make two half square triangles. Press open carefully.
3. Sew the half square triangle unit to a 3 1/2" Lt Orange Sm Animals square as shown on the left in figure 4. Add a 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Lt Orange Sm Animals rectangle to the side. Press the 6 1/2" completed block. Repeat to make another block as shown on the right in figure 4).
4. Sew a 6 7/8" Lt Orange Sm Animals triangle and an Orange Stripe 6 7/8" triangle right sides together. Press open carefully.
5. Sew into a unit one triangle cut from the 7 1/4" Lt Orange Sm Animals square and one triangle the same size from Purple Stripe (figure 5). Add to the unit one 6 7/8" Purple Stripe triangle. Press open carefully to make one 6 1/2" block.

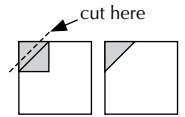

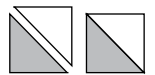

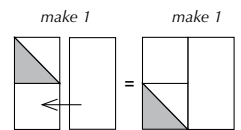

Sewing the Blocks Together

1. Lay out the various 6 1/2" squares and completed blocks and 6 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles as shown in the quilt picture and turning the striped squares.
2. Sew the squares into horizontal rows. Sew the rows together into 3 panels using 3 rows for each panel.

Adding the Borders

1. Add to the top panel a 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" strip Lt Purple Sm Animals to the left and right sides. Repeat to add strips of Lt Purple Sm Animals to the left and right sides of the bottom panel. Press the seams outward.
2. Add to the middle panel a 3 1/2" x 18 1/2" strip Lt Green Sm Animals to the left and right sides. Press the seams inward. Sew the three panels together.
3. Sew together into a border one 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" Lt Purple Sm Animals rectangle, one Lt Green Sm Animals 3 1/2" x 20" strip and one Lt Purple Sm Animals 3 1/2" x 20" strip in that order. Repeat to make two borders. Sew one border to the top and bottom of the quilt center having the short rectangle in the upper left and lower right corners. Press the seams outward.

Adding the Appliqués

1. Center and fuse the Black Everyday Organic eyes on top of the small Lt Purple Bushes triangles as shown in the quilt picture. Finish the shape edges with matching thread.
2. Lay out the raw edge 1" x 5" Orange Everyday Organic strips for the giraffe's mane as shown in the quilt picture. Stitch down the center of the strips with matching thread locking the stitches at the beginning and end.

Finishing the Quilt

1. Press the quilt top and layer for basting the top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Trim away the excess backing and batting from around the border.
2. Make binding and apply to the quilt.
